

Notice of Intention to Petition for Reinstatement and
Opportunity for Public Comment

Mr. Che-Yang (“Michael”) Chen of Diamond Bar, California, whose registration number is 64,015, and who has been suspended pursuant to 35 U.S.C. §§ 2(b)(2)(D) and 32, has filed, pursuant to 37 CFR § 11.60(h)(2), notice of his intention to petition for reinstatement. A suspended practitioner may not be reinstated unless it is established to the satisfaction of the Director of the Office of Enrollment and Discipline that reinstatement is not contrary to the public interest, and that the suspended practitioner has complied with the provisions of 37 CFR § 11.58 during his period of suspension. 37 CFR § 11.60.

Pursuant to 37 C.F.R. § 11.60(h)(1), the public may submit any comment, evidence, or other information tending to affect the eligibility for reinstatement of Mr. Che-Yang (“Michael”) Chen, on moral, ethical or other grounds to the Director of the Office of Enrollment and Discipline via written communication addressed to the Office of Enrollment and Discipline, Mail Stop OED, United States Patent and Trademark Office, P.O. Box 1450, Alexandria, VA 22313-1450, on or before 30 days after the date this notice is published.
