## Notice of Petition for Reinstatement and Opportunity for Public Comment

Yiheng Lou of Beijing, China, who has been suspended pursuant to 35 U.S.C. §§ 2(b)(2)(D) and 32, has filed a petition for reinstatement. A suspended practitioner may not be reinstated unless it is established to the satisfaction of the Director of the Office of Enrollment and Discipline that reinstatement is not contrary to the public interest, and that the suspended practitioner has complied with the provisions of 37 C.F.R. § 11.58 during his period of suspension. 37 C.F.R. § 11.60. Accordingly, information bearing upon the good moral character and reputation of Yiheng Lou is material to his eligibility for reinstatement.
