

Notice of Conditional Granting of Petition for Reinstatement

Consideration has been given to the Petition for Reinstatement of John H. Faro (Petitioner). After careful review of the Petition, the supporting affidavit, Petitioner's responses to requests for supplemental information, and all other information in the record material to Petitioner's eligibility for reinstatement, the Director of the Office of Enrollment and Discipline has determined that reinstatement of Petitioner to practice before the United States Patent and Trademark Office ("USPTO") is to be **CONDITIONALLY GRANTED**, namely: pursuant to 37 CFR § 11.60(d), Petitioner's reinstatement is conditioned upon (1) Mr. Faro notifying the OED Director, in writing, that full payment of the costs for *In re Faro*, USPTO Proceeding No. D2015-27 has been submitted to the USPTO and (2) the agency's receipt of full payment of all costs set forth in 37 CFR § 11.60(d)(2) for *In re Faro*, USPTO Proceeding No. D2015-27. Payment to the USPTO of the aforementioned disciplinary costs shall be made within 30 days of the publication of this Notice. Mr. Faro is not authorized to practice, and shall not practice, before the USPTO until the conditions have been satisfied. Further, the conditional granting of the Petition for Reinstatement shall be automatically and immediately rescinded and revoked, should the conditions not be fully satisfied within sixty (60) days of the publication of this **DECISION ON PETITION FOR REINSTATEMENT** in the Official Gazette.
