


Go to App Store (iOS) or Google Play store (Android).






Search for Duo Mobile and select **Get (iOS)** or select **Install for (Android).**




Setup Duo Mobile Account (iOS and Android)

Click the link and select **Log-in with your USPTO.gov account.**



To setup Multifactor authentication, click Configure.




iOS, open **Duo Mobile** from your mobile phone and select **Continue.**In the **Add your Account** screen, click Use a **QR Code**.







Android, click Set up account.

In the Link your account screen, click Use a QR Code.







From your mobile phone, scan the **QR code** (displayed on your desktop screen) and click **Continue.**





In the Account name field, type your email address and click Save.









To complete the setup, enter the **authentication codes** displayed on Duo Mobile app and click **Complete.**


Note: Wait 30 seconds or until the authentication code is refreshed and type the new code in the **Second authentication code** field.
