### 914 Sole protector:

This subclass is indented under subclass 909. Design that covers the bottom or underside of the shoe or boot.

(1) Note. Includes protective cover for cleat.

### 915 Heel or counter protector:

This subclass is indented under subclass 909. Design covers the rear area of footwear only.

## 916 Sandal-type:

This subclass is indented under subclass 896. Design for light shoe that attaches to the foot generally with straps.

#### 917 Bifurcated:

This subclass is indented under subclass 916. Design that includes a fastener that passes between the toes.

(1) Note. Includes "thong"- or "zorie"- type.

### 918 With distinct heel:

This subclass is indented under subclass 916. Design that includes a separate raised area under the rear of the foot.

# 919 Slipper-type:

This subclass is indented under subclass 896. Design that slides on to the foot without a fastener member and is for primarily indoor use.

(1) Note. Includes house shoe-type footware.

## 920 Substantially knitted:

This subclass is indented under subclass 919. Design that is formed substantially of yarn or yarn-type material.

This subclass is indented under subclass 896. Design designed for feminine-type durable foot covering.

## 926 Mule-type:

This subclass is indented under subclass 925. Design that is open at the rear and does not cover the heel.

### 927 Wedgie-type:

This subclass is indented under subclass 925. Design that shows a sole that is thick under the heel that gradually tapers and extends under the arch area to the toe area.

# 928 Provision for lacing or tie fastener:

This subclass is indented under subclass 927. Design that includes a provision for lace or shoestring-type fastening member.

# 929 Secured with strap, lacing or tie fastener, or with provision therefor:

This subclass is indented under subclass 925. Design that includes means or provision for tightening on to the foot with lash or shoestring.

#### 930 At ankle or heel:

This subclass is indented under subclass 929. Design wherein the strap, lacing or tie fastener or provision therefor is at the rear side or rear.

### 931 And connected to vamp:

This subclass is indented under subclass 930. Design wherein the fastening member is attached to upper part or top portion.

# 932 Sling-back-type:

This subclass is indented under subclass 931. Design wherein the fastening member is a strap or lash that surrounds the rear of the heel.

## **933** T-strap:

This subclass is indented under subclass 931. Design wherein the strap or lash member shows a T-shape configuration.

# 934 And with repeating circular or oval perforations:

This subclass is indented under subclass 933. Design that includes plural, repeating, circular or oval open or pierced areas.

#### 935 Lacing or tie fastener:

This subclass is indented under subclass 929. Design that includes lace or shoestring-type closure member.

# 936 With open toe:

This subclass is indented under subclass 935. Design wherein the toe area is not enclosed.

# 937 With repeating circular or oval perforations:

This subclass is indented under subclass 935. Design that includes plural, repeating, circular or oval open or pierced areas.

# 938 With repeating circular or oval perforations:

This subclass is indented under subclass 929. Design that includes plural, repeating, circular or oval open or pierced areas.

## 939 Slip-on-type:

This subclass is indented under subclass 925. Design that slides onto the foot without a fastener member.

(1) Note. Includes pump-type.

This subclass is indented under subclass 943. Design that includes lace or shoestring-type fastener.

# 945 And with repeating circular or oval perforations:

This subclass is indented under subclass 944. Design that includes plural, circular, or oval open or pierced areas in duplicate pattern.

### 946 Element or attachment:

## 947 Sole:

### 948 Simulative in form:

This subclass is indented under subclass 947. Design that includes an ornamental feature or features that simulate the ornamental appearance of another article in general overall form.

### 949 Half sole:

This subclass is indented under subclass 947. Design that covers the toe and arch areas only.

#### 950 Women's shoe:

This subclass is indented under subclass 947. Design for feminine-type durable foot covering.

### 951 With pattern or texture on bottom:

This subclass is indented under subclass 947. Design that includes an ornamental design on the bottom or under surface.




A typical example of a sole with a pattern or texture on the bottom.

### 952 Simulative:

This subclass is indented under subclass 951. Design that includes an ornamental feature or

features that simulate the ornamental appearance for another object as applied ornamentation.

This subclass is indented under subclass 951. Design that includes repeating zigzag or wavy or ridges.




This subclass is indented under subclass 957. Design for diamond or triangular element.


This subclass is indented under subclass 962. Design for anti-slip device used to climb pole.

#### 964 Heel:

This subclass is indented under subclass 946. Design for the built up part of shoe underside beneath the heel area only.

### 965 For women's shoe:


This subclass is indented under subclass 964. Design for feminine-type durable covering for the foot.

# 966 Spike or stiletto-type:

This subclass is indented under subclass 965. Design for tall, narrow, spike-shape type.

#### 967 With circular detail:

This subclass is indented under subclass 964. Design that includes round detail.

## 968 Heel or sole plate:

This subclass is indented under subclass 946. Design for relatively thin, hard attachment that fits on the heel or sole.

(1) Note. Includes slug, tap, or pad.

### 969 Upper:

This subclass is indented under subclass 946. Design for the top part of a shoe.

## 970 For boot:

This subclass is indented under subclass 969. Design for the top part of footwear that covers the ankle area.


(1) Note. "Boot" is defined as ankle height or higher.

## 971 For women's shoe:

This subclass is indented under subclass 946. Design for women s shoe.

## 972 Vamp, toe, heel, or side panel:


This subclass is indented under subclass 946. Design for vamp, toe, heel, or side panel.

## 973 With closure:

This subclass is indented under subclass 972. Design that includes fastener member or provision therefor.




A typical example of a vamp that includes a closure.

## 974 Vamp:

This subclass is indented under subclass 972. Design for portion of the shoe that covers the top of the foot.

# 975 Tongue or kiltie:

This subclass is indented under subclass 972. Design for projecting flap or strip member that extends from the vamp area and may support or cover the lace or shoestring member.

## 976 Detachable ornament:

This subclass is indented under subclass 946. Design for removable decorative attachment.

(1) Note. Ornament must be designed to accommodate attaching and removal from footwear.

# 977 Welt, seam, or edge detail:

This subclass is indented under subclass 946. Design for sewing-type ornamentation or ornamentation applied to the peripheral edge.

## 978 Lace or fastener:

This subclass is indented under subclass 946. Design for shoestring-type or cinch member.

(1) Note. Includes shoe lace retainer or guard.

#### 979 Shoe or boot tree:

This subclass is indented under subclass 946. Design for member used inside footwear to stabilize structure when not in use.

#### 980 STOCKING OR SOCK:

This subclass is indented under the class definition. Design for close fitting textile covering for the foot or entire leg which may extend to the lower hip.

 Note. Includes foot-worn shoe liner or "footlet"

#### 981 Simulative:

This subclass is indented under subclass 980. Design that includes an ornamental feature or features that simulate the ornamental appearance of another object either as applied ornamentation or in form.

(1) Note. The search for a hand fan that simulates the appearance of another object should also include the appropriate Design Class and subclass(es) for the actual object.

## 982 Animate:

This subclass is indented under subclass 981. Design that simulates the appearance of an animal.

#### SEE OR SEARCH CLASS:

D11, Jewelry, Symbolic Insignia, and Ornaments, subclasses 100 through 107 for medal that includes a simulation of an animal.

D21, Toys, Games, and Sports Goods, subclasses 576 through 657 for toy representation of animal.

#### 983 Stocking:

This subclass is indented under subclass 980. Design for an elongated foot and leg covering that covers the foot, lower leg and extends to the mid-thigh area.

# 984 With substantially over-all repeating texture or pattern:

This subclass is indented under subclass 983. Design that is completely covered with artistic or decorative weaving or applied design.

# 985 With contrasting detail, or with alternating pattern of stitching, weave, or texture:

This subclass is indented under subclass 983. Design that includes applied design or decorative interlacing threads in successive areas.

## 986 At heel or ankle:

This subclass is indented under subclass 985. Design that shows contrasting detail or alternating pattern of stitching, weave, or texture at the joint between the foot and lower leg or the rounded posterior portion of the foot.

# 987 And extending to thigh:

This subclass is indented under subclass 986. Design that shows the applied design at the heel or ankle and projecting to the upper portion of the leg above the knee area.

# 988 And additional distinct detail on leg or thigh:

This subclass is indented under subclass 986. Design that includes a different and characteristic design on the upper leg area.

# 989 And at toe, sole, or instep:

This subclass is indented under subclass 986. Design that includes the same pattern or applied design to the tip or end area and the underside of the foot area.

# 990 Contiguous:

This subclass is indented under subclass 989. Design where in the design extends without a beak between said areas.

### 991 At toe:

This subclass is indented under subclass 985. Design that includes contrasting detail, or with alternating pattern of stitching only at the front end.

#### 992 Circumferential:

This subclass is indented under subclass 985. Design that repeats the around the complete length of the design in bands.

# 993 With provision for fastener:

This subclass is indented under subclass 980. Design that includes lacing, button, snap, or other connecting means.

# 994 With contrasting detail, or with alternating pattern of stitching, weave, or texture:

This subclass is indented under subclass 980. Design that includes applied design or decorative interlacing threads in successive areas.

This subclass is indented under the class definition. Design that relates to apparel or haberdashery not elsewhere provided for.

(1) Note. Includes pattern, chart, or blank for making article.
