# CLASS D3, TRAVEL GOODS AND PERSONAL BELONGINGS

## **SECTION I - CLASS DEFINITION**

This class provides for design patents claiming ornamental designs for:

- 1. Hand-held fans and elements
- 2. Umbrella, parasols, canes, and crutches
- 3. Storage containers for hand-sewing-type equipment
- 4. Storage containers for shoe shine equipment, including kits
- 5. Carrier or storage containers for personal belongings
- 6. Elements and attachments specific to articles in this class

This subclass is indented under the class definition. Design for device waved manually to create a flow or current of air.

 Note. Element included in this and in indented subclasses.

D23, Environmental Heating and Cooling; Fluid Handling and Sanitary Equipment, subclasses 370 through 384 for power-type fan.

## 2 Folding:

This subclass is indented under subclass 1. Design that includes a provision for bending or sliding into a compact configuration.

### 3 Simulative:

This subclass is indented under subclass 2. Design that includes an ornamental feature or features that simulate the ornamental appearance of another object either as applied ornamentation or form.

(1) Note. The search for a hand fan that simulates the appearance of another object should also include the appropriate Design Class and subclass(es) for the actual object.

### 4 Simulative:

This subclass is indented under subclass 1. Design that includes an ornamental feature or features that simulate the ornamental appearance for another object either as applied ornamentation or form.

# 5 UMBRELLA OR PARASOL, WALKING SUPPORT:

This subclass is indented under the class definition. Design for a collapsible ribbed canopy mounted on a central pole or stick manually used to protect against rain or sun and sticktype aid used to stand or walk.

#### SEE OR SEARCH CLASS:

D12, Transportation, subclass 130 for industrial designs for walkers and subclass 133 for elements or attachments for walkers.

## 6 Simulative:

This subclass is indented under subclass 5. Design that includes an ornamental feature or features that simulate the ornamental appearance of another object either as applied ornamentation or form.

## 7 Cane or walking support:

This subclass is indented under subclass 5. Design for hand-held stick-type support used to aid standing or walking.

(1) Note. Includes swagger stick.

## SEE OR SEARCH CLASS:

D12, Transportation, subclass 130 for industrial designs for walkers and subclass 133 for elements or attachments for walkers.

## 8 Underarm support:

This subclass is indented under subclass 7. Design for support that extends to the ground from beneath the shoulder at the arm.

(1) Note. Includes crutch.

## 9 Plural tips:

This subclass is indented under subclass 7. Design that includes more than one end member or cap attachment.

### 10 Element or attachment:

This subclass is indented under subclass 5. Design for parts or accessory-type attachments for umbrella, parasol, or walking support.

- (1) Note. The subject matter in this subclass and its indented subclasses must show an element or an attachment specific to umbrellas, parasols, etc. Generic-type elements, which could also be used as elements or attachments for articles in other Design Classes, are excluded.
- (2) Note. Element or attachments for this subject matter subject matter could be included as part of a disclosure that is directed to a complete article. Accordingly, a proper search for an element or attachment should include a search for the complete article.

## 11 Carrying case or sleeve:

This subclass is indented under subclass 10. Design for protective cover or container specific for umbrella, parasol, cane, or walking support.

300, for generic sleeve-type carrier or storage container.

### 12 Handle:

This subclass is indented under subclass 10. Design for hand-type support specific to an umbrella, parasol, cane, or walking support.

D8, Tools and Hardware, subclasses 300 through 320 for handle and digests 1-10 for handle configurations.

#### 13 Combined with diverse article:

This subclass is indented under subclass 12. Design combined with an article that, if disclosed separately, would be proper subject matter for a subsequent subclass or design patent class.

### 14 Simulative:

This subclass is indented under subclass 12. Design that includes an ornamental feature or features that simulate the ornamental appearance of another object either as applied ornamentation or in form.

(1) Note. The search for a hand fan that simulates the appearance of another object should also include the appropriate Design Class and subclass(es) for the actual object.

### 15 Animate:

This subclass is indented under subclass 14. Design that includes an ornamental feature or features that simulate the ornamental appearance for an animal or part of an animal (including human animal) either as applied ornamentation or general form.

### SEE OR SEARCH CLASS:

D21, Games, Toys and Sports Goods, subclasses 576 through 657 for toy animal figure.

## 16 Offset or asymmetrical:

This subclass is indented under subclass 12. Design that lacks symmetry in general form.

### 17 Tip or ferrule:

This subclass is indented under subclass 10. Design for cap or ring used to ornament the end of an umbrella, parasol, or cane.

## SEE OR SEARCH CLASS:

D8, Tools and Hardware, subclass 374 for furniture-type tip or cap.

# 18 HAND SEWING, KNITTING, AND EMBROIDERY EQUIPMENT:

This subclass is indented under the class definition. Design for article or accessory for manually joining or decorating textile-type material with thread, yarn, or filament.

280, for sewing machine case.

- D9, Packages and Containers for Goods, subclass 700 for sewing kit or needle and thread packages.

## 20 Article storage or holder:

This subclass is indented under subclass 18. Design for storage container specific to hand sewing, knitting or embroidery equipment.

### 21 Simulative:

This subclass is indented under subclass 20. Design that includes an ornamental feature or features that simulate the ornamental appearance of another object either as applied ornamentation or in form.

(1) Note. The search for a hand fan that simulates the appearance of another object should also include the appropriate Design Class and subclass(es) for the actual object.

### 22 Pincushion:

This subclass is indented under subclass 21. Design for pad to hold pins.

# SEE OR SEARCH THIS CLASS, SUBCLASS:

27, for pincushion that does not simulate another object.

## 23 Yarn, thread, etc.:

This subclass is indented under subclass 20. Design for the storage of indeterminate length of thin, spun textile material.

## 24 Spool type:

This subclass is indented under subclass 23. Design for reel-type holder for winding yarn or thread.

## 25 Multiple spindle type:

This subclass is indented under subclass 24. Design for multiple holder or spool.

### Work holder:

This subclass is indented under subclass 20. Design for supporting sewing, needlework, or embroidery-type materials.

## SEE OR SEARCH CLASS:

- D5, Textile or Paper Yard Goods; Sheet Material, for embroidered, knitted, or crocheted material.
- D6, Furnishings, for cabinet or furniture-type storage.
- D15, Machines Not Elsewhere Specified, subclass 72 for sewing machine cabinet.

### 27 Pincushion:

This subclass is indented under subclass 20. Design for pad to hold pins.

SEE OR SEARCH THIS CLASS, SUB-CLASS:

22, for simulative pincushion.

## 28 Needle- or bodkin-type implement:

This subclass is indented under subclass 18. Design for pin device that includes a point at one end and a hole for thread at the other end used for hand sewing.

(1) Note. Includes blunt, thick needle with a large eye, and similar article.

#### SEE OR SEARCH CLASS:

- D15, Machines Not Elsewhere Specified, subclasses 69 through 77 for sewing machine needle holders claimed as elements for a sewing machine, and subclass 78 for industrial-type needle holders.

## 29 Thimble:

This subclass is indented under subclass 18. Design for finger protector used in hand sewing or embroidery.

D4, Brushware, subclass 104 for finger cot.

## 200 SHOESHINE CASE, KIT, OR FOOT-REST:

This subclass is indented under the class definition. Design for storage container for shoe polishing equipment or foot support used to support foot for shoe polishing.

### SEE OR SEARCH CLASS:

D4, Brushware, miscellaneous subclasses for shoeshine brush.

D32, Washing, Cleaning, or Drying Machine, subclass 14.1 for shoeshine machine and subclass 47 for shoe or boot scraper.

## 201 CARRIER OR STORAGE CONTAINER:

This subclass is indented under the class definition. Design for reusable container used to hold personal belongings for travel or storing.

 Note. Designs in this and indented subclasses are classified by full-line disclosure only.

## SEE OR SEARCH CLASS:

D6, Furnishings, for furniture-type storage cabinets; and subclasses 407 through 635 for storage containers and furniture specifically directed to audiovisual and information recording media, such as magnetic tape, CD-ROM, recordings, etc.

### 202 Beverage vessel:

This subclass is indented under subclass 201. Design for holding liquid.

(1) Note. Includes canteen and handled flask.

229, for body-attached beverage container, pouch, or carrier.

304 through 314 and indented subclasses, for bin, tray, or basket designed for the purpose of carrying beverage containers.

D7, Equipment for Preparing or Serving Food or Drink Not Elsewhere Specified, subclass 619 for beverage container holder or serving caddy.

D9, Packages and Containers for Goods, subclasses 600 through 762 for simulative bottles and disposable containers and subclasses 516-575 for generic bottle.

## 203.1 Medical equipment or medication:

This subclass is indented under subclass 201. Design for the storage or carrying personal medications or emergency type medications or treatment materials.

(1) Note. Includes emergency or first aid kit.

264, through 266, for eyeglass or contact lens case.

### SEE OR SEARCH CLASS:


D4, Brushware, subclass 108 for toothbrush combined with case, and subclass 199 for toothbrush storage container.

D24, Medical and Laboratory Equipment, subclass 224 for professionally administered medication, such as chemotherapy or biological specimen container.

### 203.2 Pill or tablet:

This subclass is indented under subclass 203.1. Design for the storage of pellet or wafer type medication.

## 203.3 Compartmented:

This subclass is indented under subclass 203.2. Design that shows or has a provision for being divided into plural compartments or areas.




Example of a design for a compartmental storage container for a pill or tablet.

## **203.4 Dial type:**

This subclass is indented under subclass 203.3. Design that turns, twists or swivels to release individual pill, wafer or tablet of medication.




Example of a design for a dial type storage container for a pill or tablet.

## 203.5 Tampon or bandage:

This subclass is indented under subclass 203.1. Design for container specifically designed for the storage for personal hygiene or absorbent type bandage material.

D9, Packages and Containers for Goods, subclasses 415 through 499 for box or package.

D24, Medical and Laboratory Equipment, subclass 141 for medical tampon, subclass 189 for bandage.

### 203.6 First aid kit or case:

This subclass is indented under subclass 203.1. Design for a storage container for medical articles for the care of victims of minor accidents.


### SEE OR SEARCH CLASS:

D6, Furnishings, subclasses 512 through 574 for generic article support or dispenser.

D24, Medical and Laboratory Equipment, subclasses 107 through 182 for medical tools, per se.

## 203.7 Medical worker specific:

This subclass is indented under subclass 203.6. Design for storage container for medical treatment articles designed for use by a medical technician, nurse or doctor.

### 203.8 Diabetic case:

This subclass is indented under subclass 203.6. Design for storage container for medical articles for personal care or treatment of diabetes.

(1) Note: Includes syringe case.

### 204 Musical instrument:

This subclass is indented under subclass 201. Design for article for music-type device.

## 205 Personal grooming article:

This subclass is indented under subclass 201. Design for shaving, manicure implement, or personal hygiene.

#### SEE OR SEARCH CLASS:

D4, Brushware, subclass 108 for toothbrush combined with case and subclass 199 for toothbrush storage container.

D7, Equipment for Preparing or Serving Food or Drink Not Elsewhere Specified, subclass 635 for open-type toothpick holder.

D9, Packages and Containers for Goods, subclass 735 and 736 for razor blade packaging that releases contents sequentially and subclass 748 for packaging for razor.

D28, Cosmetic Products and Toilet Articles, subclasses 56 through 60 for manicure tools; and subclass 61 for manicure rack, stand, tray, or kit.

## Writing or marking supplies:

This subclass is indented under subclass 201. Design for articles for manually held device for written communication or drawing.

(1) Note. Includes pencil box, crayon carrier, and the like.

#### SEE OR SEARCH CLASS:

D19, Office Supplies; Artists' and Teachers' Materials, subclasses 41 through 51 for marking instrument.

## 207 Key holder, chain, or case:

This subclass is indented under subclass 201. Design for storage container for article used to lock or unlock something, or series of connected links or fob for said article.

### 208 Combined with diverse article:

This subclass is indented under subclass 207. Design combined with an article normally not associated with this subject and, if disclosed separately, would be proper subject matter for a subsequent subclass or design patent class.

 Note. Excludes key holder, etc. combined with flash drive.

## SEE OR SEARCH CLASS:

D14, Recording, Communication, or Information Retrieval Equipment, subclass 480.3 for flash drive combined with key holder, chair or case.

## **209** Light:

This subclass is indented under subclass 208. Design combined with a lamp.

#### SEE OR SEARCH CLASS:

D26, Lighting, subclasses 37 through 50 for hand-held or body-attached light.

## **210** Tool:

This subclass is indented under subclass 208. Design combined with a mechanical-type instrument.

## SEE OR SEARCH CLASS:

D8, Tools and Hardware, subclasses 1 through 106 for tool.

D13, Equipment for Production, Distribution, or Transformation of Energy, subclass 168 for remote control.

D21, Games, Toys, and Sports Goods, subclasses 793 through 795 for golf-type tool.

### 211 Simulative:

This subclass is indented under subclass 207. Design that includes an ornamental feature or features that simulate the ornamental appearance of another article either as applied ornamentation or form.

## 212 Case:

This subclass is indented under subclass 207. Design for an enclosed or substantially enclosed storage-type container.

### 213 Child carrier:

This subclass is indented under subclass 201. Design for transporting infant or toddler by body means.

## SEE OR SEARCH CLASS:

D30, Animal Husbandry, subclass 109 for animal carrier.

### 214 Backpack or sling type:

This subclass is indented under subclass 213. Design that attaches or straps to the human or animal back or shoulder.

### 215 Attachable to body, apparel, or belt:

This subclass is indented under subclass 201. Design that attaches to the human body, clothing, or strip worn around the waist.

## 216 Backpack type:

This subclass is indented under subclass 215. Design that attaches to the human or animal back with straps.

D29, Equipment for Safety, Protection, and Rescue, subclasses 101.1 through 101.4 for harness-type carrier.

This subclass is indented under subclass 216. Design wherein all compartments are completely closed or covered.

## 218 Audio or communications equipment:

This subclass is indented under subclass 215. Design for listening or communication devices.

### 219 Optical article:

This subclass is indented under subclass 215. Design for vision enhancing device.

(1) Note. Includes case for camera, eyeglass, binoculars, or telescope.

# SEE OR SEARCH THIS CLASS, SUBCLASS:

263, for optical article case supported by shoulder strap.

264, for contact lens or eyeglass case.

265, and indented subclass, for eyeglass case or holder.

## SEE OR SEARCH CLASS:

D2, Apparel and Haberdashery, subclass 866 for headwear (e.g., hat) combined with glasses.

D16, Photography and Optical Equipment, subclass 339 for sling-type eyeglasses attached-type retainer.

## 220 Scabbard or sheath for cutting implement or sword:

This subclass is indented under subclass 215. Design for cutting implement such as saber, dagger, or hunting knife.

## SEE OR SEARCH CLASS:

D22, Arms, Pyrotechnics, Hunting and Fishing Equipment, subclass 118 for sword or hunting knife.

## 221 Sports equipment or sporting goods:

This subclass is indented under subclass 215. Design for athletic-type items.

## SEE OR SEARCH THIS CLASS, SUB-CLASS:

255, for golf bag.

328.1, for golf bag holder or support.

### SEE OR SEARCH CLASS:

D2, Apparel and Haberdashery, subclass 905 for athletic shoe combined with pocket.

D6, Furnishings, subclass 552 for wall-mounted or fixed-type rack or holder for sports articles.

D22, Arms, Pyrotechnics, Hunting and Fishing Equipment, subclass 107 for quiver.

## 222 Firearm holster:

This subclass is indented under subclass 221. Design for gun- or rifle-type holder.

#### 223 Simulative:

This subclass is indented under subclass 222. Design that includes an ornamental feature or features that simulate the ornamental appearance of another article either as applied ornamentation or form.

# 224 Plural repeating pouches, cradles, or receivers:

This subclass is indented under subclass 221. Design for identical, multiple holder or slot-type holder.

### SEE OR SEARCH CLASS:

D2, Apparel and Haberdashery, subclass 864 for apron-type tool and subclass 839 for vest- or jacket-type multiple holder (e.g., fisherman's- or photographer's-type vest).

## 225 Lid or flap closure:

This subclass is indented under subclass 221. Design for holder or an attached top that bends or folds to close.

# SEE OR SEARCH THIS CLASS, SUBCLASS:

230, for body attached carrier with lid or flap closure specific to sport goods or sporting goods.

## 226 Purse, pouch, or cradle:

This subclass is indented under subclass 215. Design that includes an attached or suspended holder.

### 227 Document sleeve:

This subclass is indented under subclass 226. Design that includes a provision for paper document.

 Note. Includes holder for identification card.

### SEE OR SEARCH CLASS:

D19, Office Supplies; Artists' and Teachers' Materials, subclasses 86 through 92 for office-type document holder or file.

## 228 For tool or component thereof:

This subclass is indented under subclass 226. Design that includes a provision for manual work equipment or part thereof.

905, for tool or tackle box cross-reference art.

## SEE OR SEARCH CLASS:

D2, Apparel and Haberdashery, subclass 839 for vest or jacket-type multiple holder (e.g., fisherman's- or photographer's- type vest) and subclass 864 for apron-type tool.

# 229 Circular in cross section, or for circular or cylindrical article:

This subclass is indented under subclass 226. Design that includes a provision for round or tubular or round in cross section.

### 230 Lid or flap closure:

This subclass is indented under subclass 226. Design that includes top that bends or folds a lid to close.

# SEE OR SEARCH THIS CLASS, SUB-CLASS:

225, for body-attached holder or carrier for sports goods with lid or flap closure.

through 253, for wallet.

## 231 Saddlebags type:

This subclass is indented under subclass 201. Design for saddlebags or consisting of a pair of identical or substantially similar connected holders that are intended to be slung or draped over another object or article.

### 232 Handbag or purse:

This subclass is indented under subclass 201. Design for article designed primarily for women to hold and carry personal effects.

(1) Note. Includes women's pocketbook, clutch bag, and the like.

This subclass is indented under subclass 247. Design that includes a provision for paper currency, such as a billfold.

## With snap closure:

This subclass is indented under subclass 250. Design that includes a snap fastener or "press stud".













Example of a design for a storage container that simulates a building.



Example of a design for a storage container that simulates furniture.






Example of a design for a storage that simulates a plant.
